Lesson Objectives

- Calculate deviation from the mean.
- Calculate mean absolute deviation.
- Determine how many data points lie within one or two mean absolute deviations.

For a data value, the deviation from the mean measures the signed distance $\frac{1}{2}$					
m the mean to each data value.					
Each deviation is calculated by subtracting the mean from that data value.					
The mean absolute deviation is found by adding the absolute values of the					
deviations and dividing that sum by the number of data values					
Two ways to measure dispersion are range and deviation from the mean.					
Number of points scored in a basketball game by players who played for 30 minutes or more:					
24, 15, 10, 8, 3					
Find the deviations from the mean.					
12, 3, -2, -4, -9					
Find the mean absolute deviation.					
6 points					
3 Determine the number of players who scored within 1 mean absolute deviation
