## Set 1

(1) Ryan named the ray $\overrightarrow{T R}$. Sherman named the ray $\overrightarrow{R T}$. Which student is correct? Explain your answer.

Maryscott named the ray below $\overrightarrow{A B}$. Joe named the ray $\overrightarrow{A C}$. Which student is correct? Explain your answer.


## Possible Answers

Set 1

1. Sherman is correct because a ray is named using two letters, with the endpoint being the first letter and a point on the ray being the second letter. The correct name for this ray is $\overrightarrow{R T}$. Ryan described a ray with endpoint at $T$, passing through $R$.
2. Both students are correct. Both students' names for the ray have the endpoint, $A$, first, then another point on the ray second. Any other point on the ray can be used as the second letter.
