Possible Answers

Set 1

- 1. Yes: An equilateral triangle has three sides that are equal in measure. All the angles are also equal in measure. Therefore, it can be classified as equilateral and regular.
- 2. Sometimes: A rectangle always has four equal angles, each measuring ninety degrees. A square is a special kind of rectangle, where all four sides are also equal in length. When a rectangle is also a square, it is a regular polygon.
